If the Candidate intends to provide legal services <u>after</u> their placement term concludes and while awaiting the Candidate's Call to the Bar, the Candidate agrees to read <u>Section IV of the Rights of Appearance</u> and complete the following section to confirm a Supervision Agreement with the Law Society for the period following the Candidate's placement term. If the Candidate and Principal intend to enter into a Supervision Agreement after the placement has concluded, the Candidate and Principal must complete the section below:

- b. The Candidate and the Supervising Lawyer understand that the Candidate may only provide legal services under the direct supervision of the Supervising Lawyer, pursuant to this Supervision Agreement.
- c. The Candidate and the Supervising Lawyer understand that the Candidate has the same ability to provide legal services, including the right to appear before Ontario courts and tribunals in certain matters, as those candidates who are serving under Articles of Clerkship or the Law Practice Program work placement term. The Candidate's responsibilities and obligations are also the same as those that apply to Candidates who are serving under Articles of Clerkship, and the Supervising Lawyer has the same responsibilities and obligations as a Principal, except that neither the Candidate nor the Supervising Lawyer is required to provide any further documentation to the Law Society with respect to the employment relationship.
- d. The Supervising Lawyer agrees to supervise no more than two Candidates at any one time, which includes Candidate(s) being supervised within a placement or being supervised under a Supervision Agreement.
- e. The Candidate agrees to inform the Supervising Lawyer before entering into another Supervision Agreement that overlaps with any portion of the period in paragraph a. above.

¹ Supervision Agreements will generally be approved for a period of up to a maximum of six months.
