

Temporary Assignment of Articling Placement

THIS FORM MUST be completed and filed by an articling candidate within 10 business days of the start of the temporarily assigned articling placement. The Temporary Assignment of Articling Placement is to be filed when the assignment will be for a minimum of four weeks to a maximum of three months and the articling candidate will return to the placement indicated on the original Articles of Clerkship.

LATE FILING OF THIS FORM RESULTS IN A LATE FILING FEE OF \$100 (plus applicable taxes).
