*Justice Campbell possessed a keen legal mind. Few can surpass his sense of legal history or his knowledge of the law.*

*Called to the Bar of Ontario in 1969, he had a distinguished legal career as the Director of the Parkdale Community Legal Services, a law teacher, an advocate, and a public servant.*

*In 1986, he was appointed to the Superior Court of Justice. Confidence in his judicial skills was demonstrated by his appointment as Commissioner of the Bernado Investigation Review and the SARS Commission Inquiry.*

*Few others of his generation have achieved such distinction and served so well. I request you, Sir, to confer upon him the degree of Doctor of Laws, honoris causa.*
