Smith, Rae & Greer was a prominent Toronto-based law firm, founded by partners Larratt William Violet Smith, James Frederick Smith, George Martin Rae and John Greer.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of records created and accumulated by the Toronto law firm of Smith, Rae and Greer. The records in this fonds include correspondence with clients and a copy of a marriage settlement.
