## **George Shepley collection. -- 1907-1916. -- 3 cm of textual records**

### **Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History**

George Shepley (1852-1916) was a prominent lawyer, who acted as counsel for several governments and served as a member of the Royal Commission on Dominion Railroads. Shepley served as Treasurer of the Law Society of Upper Canada from 1913 to 1916.

### **Scope and Content**

Collection consists of loose newspaper clippings on the death of Shepley, and a scrapbook containing clippings on his involvement with the Royal Commission on Life Insurance. It is believed the clippings were accumulated by Shepley's two daughters.

### **Provenance**

The records in this collection were donated to the Law Society by Beatrice Shepley and Helena Shepley in 1977. Further clippings were forwarded to the Law Society in 1982.
