Scope and Content

Item is a printed statement of defence made by Mrs. Helen Philp against a summons of divorce brought by David Hodge, of Bombay (formerly of Edinburgh), her husband, in the Outer House, Scotland. The document details the date of the marriage, the nature of her defence and the relationship between the parties. Philp was the daughter of James Philp, of Dumfermline, sister of James Philp, and wife of second husband Martin Rigny, a china merchant from Kirkcaldy.
