Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History

John Leslie Prentice was born on January 19th, 1886, in Wellington County, Ontario. He attended the University of Toronto, where he received a BA degree in 1922. That same year, he enrolled in Osgoode Hall Law School. He articulated with Morley Calvin Pritchard, in Toronto, and was called to the Bar in 1926. He became a King's Counsel in 1935. Primarily a Toronto-based lawyer, Prentice also served as a magistrate in the Magistrates' Court in Toronto from 1938 to 1961. In 1935, an interest in politics led Prentice to run, unsuccessfully, for federal parliament as a member of the Liberal party in the Toronto riding of Parkdale. Prentice retired from law in 1980. He died on October 2nd, 1989, at the age of 103.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of records pertaining to the professional life of John Leslie Prentice, a Toronto-based lawyer, bencher of the Law Society of Upper Canada, and magistrate. The materials in this fonds relate to his educational and legal certifications in particular. These records include diplomas, commissions, certificates and photographs.
