## **Henry Bonnycastle fonds. -- 1834, 1879. -- 2 p.**

### **Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History**

Henry William John Bonnycastle was born on July 24th, 1813, to Sir Richard Henry Bonnycastle and Frances Johnstone. He was admitted as a student-at-law by the Law Society of Upper Canada in 1834, but was never called to the Bar, having pursued a military career like his father. Bonnycastle died on July 23rd, 1888 in Campbellford, Ontario.

### **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of an admission certificate to the Law Society of Upper Canada and a letter from John A. Macdonald, first Prime Minister of Canada.
