Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History

John Monk was born on November 11th, 1820, in St. John's, Quebec. He was called to the Bar of Quebec and practiced law in Montreal for most of his career. Monk died in Montreal on November 9th, 1881.

Scope and Content

Collection consists of records pertaining to the life and activities of John Monk, a Quebec-based lawyer. These records include a photocopy and transcriptions of a letter written by Monk during a trip from Quebec to San Francisco.

Scope and Content

File consists of records pertaining to the travels of John Monk, a Quebec lawyer. Records include a photocopy of a letter from Monk to his wife, Elizabeth, and two transcriptions of the letter. The letter details Monk's travels through Eastern Ontario and Toronto, with extended mention of Osgoode Hall and a tour conducted by Sheriff Jarvis. The transcriptions date from different periods. Both are typescript documents, one created in 1962 and one undated.
