Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History

George Mortimer Kelley was admitted as a student-at-law by the Law Society of Upper Canada in 1888, and was called to the Bar in 1898. He practiced law in Toronto, Ontario. Kelley died on September 22nd, 1963.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of records accumulated and created by George Mortimer Kelley, a Toronto-based lawyer who was involved with the County of York Law Association. The records in this fonds pertain to tariff and fees for legal services, and appear to be accumulated for use as reference materials by Kelley. Included in the fonds are a number of pieces of correspondence.
