Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History

Scope and Content

Collection consists of legal documents accumulated by Mildred Fraser. The documents relate to legal transaction in England and Canada. Included are a letters patent and three letters of administration.

985115-001 Letters patent assigned from John Barbour to John Kent Turner and Francis William Marriott. -- 17 June 1862. -- 1 p. ; 58 x 76.5 cm

Scope and Content

Item is an assignment of a letters patent from John Barbour, a merchant of Liverpool, County of Lancaster, to John Kent Turner and Francis William Marriott of John Walters and Company, Globe Works, Sheffield, in the County of York. The agreement pertains to a letters patent dated 16 April 1862 for an invention to render "improvements applicable to upholsterers and other hammers." The letters patent was transferred to Turner and Marriott for fourteen years and the sum of two hundred pounds. Also mentioned in the document is William Thomson of the law firm Thomson and Burns, Toronto, lawyer for John Barbour. The document details the rights and obligations of the parties involved.

985115-002 Letters of administration for Walter Lock. -- 22 Sept. 1897. -- 1 p. ; 31 x 26 cm

Scope and Content

Item is a letters of administration of the estate of Walter Lock of Gravenhurst, Muskoka, a widower who died on 19 November 1896. It assigns the management of his estate to Reverend Thomas Parkin on behalf of Lock's daughter and only next-of-kin, Eliza Mary Caroline Cassel, wife of John Cassel of Smith Avenue, Hamilton. The document was issued by the High Court of Justice, Probate Division, England.

985115-003 Letters of administration regarding Eliza Lock. -- 12 Oct. 1897. -- 1 p. ; 31 x 26 cm

Scope and Content

Item is a letters of administration of the estate of Eliza Lock of Gravenhurst, Muskoka, who died on 5 April 1887. The document details the complications of managing her estate, as her next-of-kin, Walter Lock, also died before he obtained letters of administration for her estate. Consequently, the management of her estate is assigned to Reverend Thomas Parkin on behalf of Eliza and Walter Lock's daughter, Eliza Mary Caroline Cassel, wife of John Cassel of Smith Avenue, Hamilton. The document was issued by the High Court of Justice, Probate Division, England.

985115-004 Letters of administration for Sidney Smith Marsh. -- 5 Sept. 1900. -- 1 p. ; 31 x 26 cm

Scope and Content

Item is a letters of administration of the estate of Sidney Smith Marsh of Newmarket, County of York, who died on 22 March 1897. It assigns the management of his estate to Charles Basford Hobbis, an attorney, on behalf of Marsh's widow, Rachel Marsh. The document was issued by the High Court of Justice, Probate Division, England.
