Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History

Richard Estcourt Holland was born on September 9th, 1925. He attended the University of Toronto, where he received a BA degree in 1947. He was called to the Bar of Ontario in 1950, and was appointed a Queen's Counsel in 1962. Holland served as a Justice on the Supreme Court of Ontario - High Court of Justice from 1972 to 1990. Holland died on March 27th, 2002.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of a leather-bound volume containing the Supreme Court Act, amendments to the Act, and the Rules of the Supreme Court of Canada, that originally belonged to Justice Frank Hughes of the Supreme Court of Canada. Also included is a red trial gown.
