**Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History**

Rose Greenstein was born in Montreal, Quebec. She attended the University of Toronto, where she obtained a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1946. She was admitted to Osgoode Hall Law School in 1955, and was called to the Bar in 1959. Her son, Hershel Gross, is also a lawyer. The two practiced together for several years following his call to the Bar.

**Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of two photographs taken shortly after Rose Greenstein began attending Osgoode Hall Law School, and a photograph of Greenstein with her son, Hershel Gross.

**Provenance**

On June 25th, 2009, a luncheon was held at Osgoode Hall to honour the 50th anniversary of the call to the Bar of Rose Greenstein. The luncheon was organized by Hershel Gross, the son of Greenstein and a member of the Law Society staff. The day following the luncheon, Gross gave the archives two photographic prints taken during his mother's time at Osgoode Hall Law School. He also loaned the archives a photograph of himself and his mother taken by The Telegram on the day Rose Greenstein was called to the Bar (25 June 1959). The photograph was scanned by the Archivist and the original returned to Gross.
