Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History

Nicholas John Pustina (1933-) is a lawyer in Thunder Bay, Ontario. He was a bencher of the Law Society (2007-2015) and president of the Thunder Bay Law Association (1972).

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of copies of records created and maintained by Nicholas Pustina mainly pertaining to the history and activities of the Thunder Bay Law Association, for which he served as a secretary (1970) and president (1972). These records include correspondence, event guest lists, a member list, a newspaper clipping, meeting minutes, a suggested fee schedule, and newsletters.

Also included are event guest lists, a 1959 association member list, a newspaper article on legal aid (29 Mar. 1952), minutes from a meeting of the Federation of Law Associations of Ontario (2 June 1955), a newspaper clipping re: the opening of a law office by R.E. Zelinski and Nicholas J. Pustina, a suggested minimum fee schedule for the association (1982), a Lakehead Cities 1950 telephone directory, an essay by Ted Burton entitled "Law and order go north", and correspondence by Nicholas Pustina to the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation re: Hockey Night in Canada (2001).
