### **Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History**

#### **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of certificates appointing Clark a judge of the County Court of the United Counties of Northumberland and Durham and a judge of the High Court of Justice for Ontario. Certificates naming Clark to other appointments, including two commissions of inquiry and a Queen's Counsel are also included. The fonds also includes two legal documents and newspaper clippings of a letter to the editor of *The Globe*.

The records in this fonds were presented to the Riddell Canadian Library by Frank Meade Field, K.C., of Cobourg, Ontario, in 1917. The fonds was transferred to the archives from an unknown source in 1985.
