Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History

David Park Jamieson was born in Forest, Ontario, on March 2nd, 1903. He was admitted to Osgoode Hall Law School in 1919, and was called to the Bar in 1924. Jamieson was a sole practitioner in Sarnia, Ontario, until he joined the firm of Pardee, Gurd, Fuller and Taylor in 1938. He served with the Royal Canadian Air Force during the Second World War, and was awarded the Order of the British Empire in 1943. Jamieson was appointed a King's Counsel in 1945. He served as an elected bencher of the Law Society of Upper Canada from 1946 to 1961, and as a life bencher from 1961 to 1981. Jamieson served as president of the Canadian Bar Association from 1954 to 1955. Jamieson held a number of positions with organizations and boards, including the Sarnia Chamber of Commerce and the Sarnia Drama Club. He received honorary LL.D. degrees from the University of New Brunswick (1954) and the University of Ottawa (1955). Jamieson died in Sarnia, Ontario, on February 10th, 1981.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of photographs maintained by Jamieson documenting two speaking occasions and other events of his life. Also included are group photographs taken at Canadian Bar Association annual meetings, photographs of a University of Ottawa ceremony, and a photograph of Lord Denning.

Provenance

The records in this fonds were sent to Kenneth Jarvis, Secretary of the Law Society, by the executor of Jamieson's estate in 1982. At that time, the photographs were filed with Jamieson's general member file. In 1992, Ann-Marie Langlois, Archives Manager, removed the material from the file and transferred it to Archives.
