**Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History**

The Toronto Dominion Bank Archives, located in Toronto, Ontario, houses the records of the Toronto-Dominion Bank, the Bank of Toronto and the Dominion Bank.

**Scope and Content**

Collection consists of photographs, and a postage stamp, accumulated by the Toronto Dominion Bank Archives and subsequently deaccessioned from their collection.

**Provenance**

The photographs included in accession 2003.033 were acquired by the Toronto Dominion Bank Archives from an unknown source. The photographs included in accession 2005.015 were originally included in records from Canada Trust. The photographs were deaccessioned from their collection and offered to the Law Society Archives.

S1439 Envelope bearing "Imperial penny postage, Sir William Mulock". -- 1998. -- 1 postal cover

*Scope and Content*

Item is an envelope bearing the Canadian postage stamp "Imperial penny postage, Sir William Mulock". The stamp features an 1898 postage stamp and a photo of Sir William Mulock. The stamp honours the one hundred year anniversary of imperial penny postage. Sir William Mulock was Postmaster General at the time.
