The Advocates' Society was established on November 20th, 1963, with the intention of being a forum for discussion, education and fellowship among advocates. The first meeting was held on May 17th, 1965, where John J. Robinette became the first president. The Society owns and operates Sir William Campbell House, located in downtown Toronto, and produces the Advocates' Society Journal among other publications.
