Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History

Michael Walsh was admitted as a student-at-law by the Law Society of Upper Canada in 1861, and was called to the Bar in 1866. He practiced law in Ingersoll, Ont. Walsh was appointed a King's Counsel in 1908. Michael Walsh died on August 31st, 1932.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of records relating to the legal career of Michael Walsh. Included is correspondence relating to his appointment as a King's Counsel in 1908, and fee certificates from the Law Society of Upper Canada.

Provenance

The records in the fonds were donated to the archives by Robert M. Halpern, a lawyer in Toronto, Ont. Halpern purchased the items from an antiques dealer operating in southwestern Ontario on October 31, 2006. Halpern did not know how the dealer came into possession of the items.

Restrictions

No restrictions on access.

Scope and Content

File consists of two letters to Michael Walsh from the Assistant Provincial Secretary, Department of the Provincial Secretary. In one letter, Walsh is informed that he has been appointed a King's Counsel. The other is a cover letter accompanying the commission (certificate) appointing Walsh a King's Counsel.

Scope and Content

Item is a letter to Michael Walsh from William Henry Moore, a lawyer in Peterborough, Ontario. Moore congratulates Walsh on his appointment as a King's Counsel and reminisces about their time studying together at the office of Richards and Smith.

Scope and Content

Item is a letter to Michael Walsh from Saunders & Rowan, tailors in Toronto, seeking to sell Walsh a King's Counsel outfit. The letter lists the prices for King's Counsel silk robes, a bag, a coat and vest.
