## **Frederick William Jarvis fonds. -- 1875-1883. -- 7 cm of textual records**

### **Biographical/Sketch/Administrative History**

Frederick William Jarvis (1818-1887) served as Sheriff of the United Counties of York and Peel.

### **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of records maintained by Frederick William Jarvis in his capacity as Sheriff of York County. The fonds consists largely of writs of fieri facias (writs of execution) authorising the Sheriff to take possession of goods to pay debts. Also included are correspondence, inventories of goods, bank deposits, records of payment, and a volume containing an index of cases in lis pendens (cases pending).
