Order

This Application, made by the Applicant, Law Society of Ontario (“Law Society”) for a permanent injunction against the Respondent, Charles Z. Wallace, a.k.a. Evan Wallace (“Mr. Wallace”), was heard this day at the court house, 393 University Avenue, Toronto, Ontario, M5G 1E6.

On reading the Application Record, Factum and Brief of Authorities of the Law Society, and on hearing submissions from counsel for the Law Society, with Mr. Wallace having neither delivered a Notice of Appearance nor appearing at the hearing of the Application.

1. This Court orders that Mr. Wallace is permanently enjoined from practising law in Ontario or providing legal services in Ontario through any company or business entity.
2. This Court orders that Mr. Wallace and any company or business entity controlled by him are permanently enjoined from advertising or holding Mr. Wallace out as a person or entity who may practise law in Ontario or provide legal services in Ontario, contrary to section 26.1 of the *Law Society Act*.
3. This Court orders that Mr. Wallace shall, within ten (10) days of the date that he is served with this Order, take all steps necessary to permanently remove the version of Mr. Wallace’s LinkedIn profile accessible online as of September 13, 2018 (a copy of which is attached as a Schedule “A” to this Order) from the Internet and any other media;
4. This Court orders that Mr. Wallace shall take all steps necessary to remove any representations in any and all media that Mr. Wallace is a lawyer, legal services professional, counsel, paralegal, a member of the law Society or the Ontario bar, or may otherwise practice law in Ontario or provide legal services in Ontario, within ten (10) days of the date that he is served with this Order, or within ten (10) days of becoming aware of such representations, as appropriate.
5. This Court orders that Mr. Wallace shall provide a copy of this Order, and any related reasons or endorsement, to each of his current clients by letter, facsimile transmission, or email message, and copy counsel for the Law Society with all such letters,

facsimile transmissions, and email messages, as the case may be within ten (10) days of the date that he is served with this Order.

Transcription Note: This paragraph originally stated that Mr. Wallace was ordered to “provide a copy of this Order, and any related reasons or endorsement, to each of his current and prospective clients” but the phrase “and prospective” was crossed out by hand and initialled in the final order.

6. This Court orders that, in the event Mr. Wallace fails to take any of the steps required by the terms of this Order, or otherwise fails to comply with this Order, the Law Society may move for such further and ancillary relief as may be necessary to compel Mr. Wallace to comply with the terms of this Order, including but not limited to an Order declaring Mr. Wallace to be in contempt of Court and imposing any penalty contemplated by *Rules of Civil Procedure*, R.R.O. 1990, Reg. 194.

7. This Court orders that the Law Society may in its discretion publish this Order in such media as it deems appropriate.

8. This Court orders that the Law Society serve a copy of this Order on Mr. Wallace forthwith by mailing a copy by ordinary and registered mail to 66 Duffort Court, Scarborough, ON M1B 2R9, such service to be deemed effective as personal service 10 days after the date of mailing.

9. This court orders that costs are payable by Mr. Wallace to the Law Society in the amount of \$4,850.00 (inclusive of disbursements and HST), within thirty (30) days of the date of this order.
