Order

This Application, by the Applicant for a permanent injunction against the Respondent was heard this day at 393 University Avenue, Toronto, Ontario M5G 1E6.

On reading the Application Record and Supplementary Application Record and upon hearing the submissions of counsel for The Law Society of Upper Canada and Bill Akleh ("Akleh") personally,

1. This Court orders that Akleh is permanently enjoined from engaging in the practice of law or in the provision of legal services in Ontario in contravention of section 26.1 of the *Law Society Act*, R.S.O. 1990 c.L.8 as amended (the "Act").
2. This Court orders that the Respondent Akleh is permanently enjoined from advertising or holding himself out as a person who may practise law or provide legal services in Ontario, contrary to section 26.1 of the *Act*.

[3] This Court orders that the Applicant may in its discretion publish this Order in such media as it deems appropriate.

3. This Court orders that the Respondent shall forthwith pay the Applicant its costs of this application fixed in the amount of \$5000.00.

4. This order bears interest at the rate of 3% from its date.
