- 1. This Court orders that the Respondent and any entity or person controlled by him is permanently enjoined from engaging in the practice of law and from engaging in the provision of legal services in contravention of section 26.1 of the *Law Society Act*, R.S.O. 1990 c.L.8 as amended (the "*Act*").
- 2. This Court orders that the Respondent is permanently enjoined from holding himself out as a person who may practise law or provide legal services in Ontario, contrary to section 26.1 of the *Act*.
- 3. This Court orders that the Applicant may in its discretion publish this Order in such media as it deems appropriate.
- 4. This Court orders that the Respondent shall forthwith pay the Applicant its costs of this application fixed in the amount of \$500.00.
- 5. This Court orders that the Respondent shall forthwith pay to Jorge Pintos the amount of \$500.00.
- 6. This order bears interest at the rate of 2% from its date.
