This Motion, made by the Law Society of Upper Canada for an Order finding the Respondent, Ken Miller in contempt of the Order made by the Honourable Mr. Justice E.J. Koke of the Ontario Superior Court of Justice on the 16th day of March, 2010, was heard on the 2nd day of May, 2014 and having so found was adjourned to this day at Newmarket for the determination and imposition of penalty.

On reading the materials filed and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the Applicant and on hearing the submission of the Respondent, both appearing in person:

1. This Court orders that upon the joint submission adopted, penalty for Mr. Miller's contempt imposed: 12 days jail to be served intermittently, Friday at 8:00 p.m. to Monday at 6:00 a.m.
2. This Court further orders that the Society's costs shall be paid by Mr. Miller on a substantial indemnity basis fixed at \$15,695.75.

This order bears interest at the rate of 3.0 per cent per year commencing on the 13th day of February, 2015.
